A Professor at the Université de Moncton in Chemistry and Biochemistry and a Canada Research Chair (CRC) in Cellular Lipid Metabolism, Dr. Surette conducts 21st century biomedical research involving time and efforts to train and mentor students, supervise staff, publish and present, while also serving on many administrative, academic and research regional, national and international peer review and conference organizing committees. His research program is all about biochemistry, cell biology, nutrition and immunology. He specializes in fatty acid (such as omega 3 from the diet) pathways and how they contribute to cell function and impact on cardiovascular and inflammatory diseases, as well as cancer, particularly breast cancer. <http://www.yourlife.com/health/ny-2016/06/15/>

Dr. Surette obtained his B.Sc. with Honours in Biochemistry (Dalhousie University), M.Sc. (Technical University of Nova Scotia) and Ph.D. in Food Chemistry/Immunology (Cornell University, USA). He completed two Post-doctoral training programs, one in Immunology and Physiology at the CHUQ (Centre Hospitalier Universitaire de Québec) and one in Pulmonary Medicine (Wake Forest University School of Medicine).

Over his 13 year career in academia, he has attracted over \$10M in research funding and salary awards (CRC, CHRF (Canadian Institutes of Health Research), NSFC (Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada / New Brunswick Chapter), CFI (Canada Foundation for Innovation), NSERC (National Science and Engineering Research Council), CBOF (Canadian Breast Cancer Foundation), and recently, an additional \$5.7M from 2 separate ACDA-RF (Atlantic Innovation Fund) grants.

Currently Training and mentoring: 3 honours students, 7 graduate students and 1 post-doctoral fellow, (previously, an additional 30 trainees). - Patents (4), publications (56), book chapters (8), presentations (70).

By recruiting talented researchers like Dr. Surette, we are contributing to the global effort to prevent, find cures and improve treatments for serious diseases. We are also creating a robust research environment that will train our students to become the talented health researchers of tomorrow.
